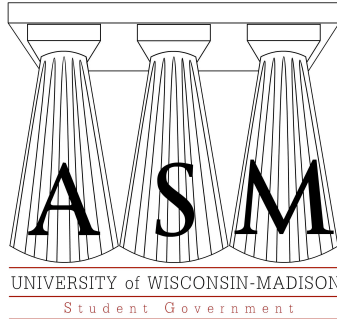

Title: 128 Information Act

Whereas, many questions remain regarding State transfer of auxiliary funds, aka "the seg fee sweep";

Therefore the Associated Students of Madison, acting in Student Council, do ordain:

Resolved, The ASM student council requests the Director of ASM Staff and Programs prepare for the Student Council a written report detailing the history and outcomes of the Seg Fee Sweep, along with the details of any future sweeps that may occur; and,

Resolved, that such report will include all supporting materials, including, but not limited to, full copies of email exchanges, financial statements and projections (and documentation concerning their provenance), full attribution and summaries, as best as possible, of any conversations ASM staff and leadership had with UW administration, and citations to relevant State and University statutes and rules that were applicable; and,

Resolved, this report will be presented for acceptance to the Council around the end of November, subject to reasonable scheduling with the Chair of ASM.
